Shorter exchanges	All programmes are open for shorter exchanges.	
Courses offered in English	Kristiania University College offers a wide variety of bachelor's and master's courses taught in English.	
Structure of study programmes	Bachelor: 3 years, 180 ECTS. Most courses give 7,5 ECTS. Master: Modules of 3-4 weeks. 2 years full-time, 3 years part-time, 120 ECTS.	

Grading system	The Norwegian grading system consists of two grading scales: Pass/Fail and A-F where E is the weakest passing grade. The grading scale has the following qualitative descriptions: A-Excellent; B-Very good; C-Good; D-Satisfactory; E-Sufficient; F-Fail. The scale is used absolutely (criterion-referenced assessment).
Transcript of record	The student can order a transcript of record in Studentweb for a limited time after the exchange (approx. 6 months). A digital transcript (pdf) will be generated automatically to the document folder in your profile.
