Application procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Ask the coordinator at your home university to send us your online nomination through Mobility Online.</li> <li>◆ Students will be invited to start the application process after an online nomination is submitted via Mobility-Online</li> <li>◆ We only accept online applications</li> <li>◆ A learning agreement which is signed by the student and home university has to be uploaded before the application deadline</li> </ul>

Language requirements	<p><b><u>Minimum requirements</u></b></p> <p>To ensure you do well, most Exchange programmes require Common European Framework (CEFR) level B2.</p> <p>A number of HU exchange programmes require you to submit proof of your English proficiency, such as official TOEFL/IELTS test results or a recommendation letter from your home university's international coordinator or English teacher.</p>
Deadlines for housing application	Students are advised to apply for housing as soon as it becomes available. Rooms are allocated on a 'first come first serve' basis as rooms are limited.
Nearest airport	Schiphol Airport (Amsterdam) – direct train from Schiphol to Utrecht Central Station (30 minutes)
